## Bingo for Prizes - How to Play & Claim:

 Complete challenges to earn Bingos—vertical, horizontal, or diagonal

 **One Bingo** = one prize

 **Two Bingos** = one prize

 **Three Bingos** = one prize + one entry into the grand prize drawing. Keep going if you'd like!

 **Blackout (complete the full card)** = one additional grand prize entry

Once you've achieved one, two, or three Bingos—or a blackout—fill out one of the Bingo Card Submission sections below. Then visit the Windsor or Severance Library during prize check-in hours to turn in your card to staff for review and to claim your prize.

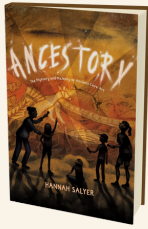

Listen to an audiobook (or read for 20 minutes).

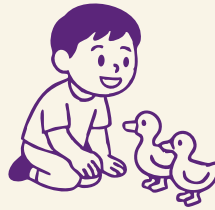


Watch a movie or TV show on Kanopy Kids (or read for 20 minutes).

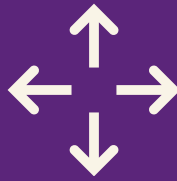
Try a new food from a cookbook you check out (or read for 20 minutes).
