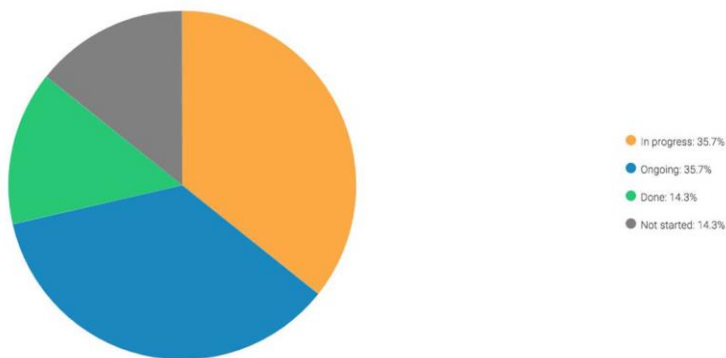




Clearview Library District Strategic Plan, First Quarter Highlights, April, 2020

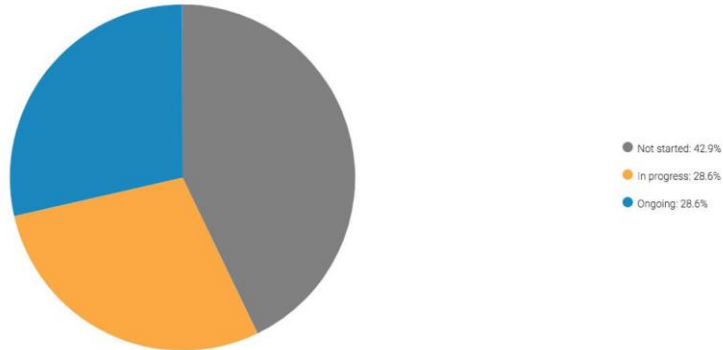
Communication Highlights

- Katie VanMeter completed the 2020 communications plan with input from the administrative staff.
- Katie VanMeter met and established relationships with the Towns of Windsor and Severance communications staff, Severance internet provider, and new contacts at the Greeley Tribune. Katie also reached out to the Weld RE-4 School District and Windsor Severance Fire Rescue.
- Underway with the incorporation of State Department of Education materials, including a forthcoming newsletter article with an interview from a state staffer.



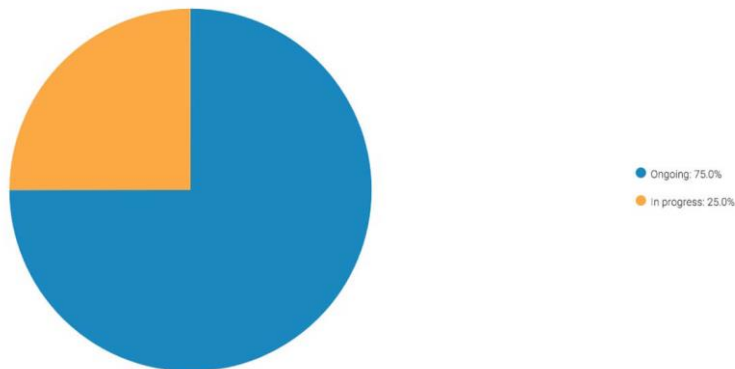
Partnerships

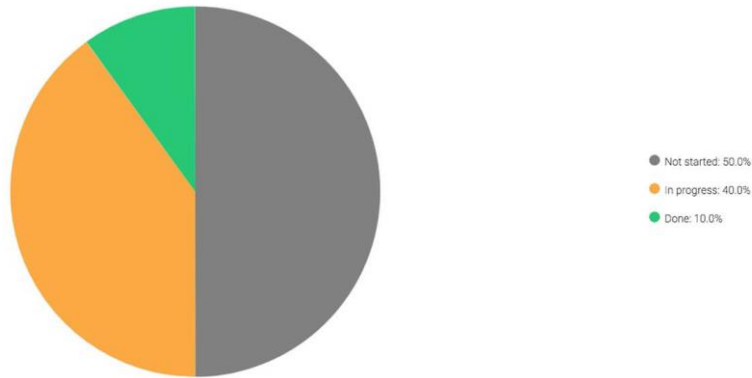
Programs and Services

- Hired Ratio Design to evaluate the current library and make recommendations for a three-tiered approach to a refresh and more efficient use of the space.
